Dr. Mirabile attended the University of Florida for his undergraduate education and graduated from their Family Medicine Residency Program in 2005. From 2005 through 2009, Dr. Mirabile worked full-time at the Halifax Dunn Health Center in Daytona Beach serving the low income, underinsured patient population of Volusia County as well as part-time in the Halifax Health Emergency Department. He has also taught future physicians about addiction medicine, mental health care, and primary health care.

Dr. Mirabile was part of the clinical faculty for the Florida State University College of Medicine as a clerkship instructor for third-year medical students as well as for Halifax Family Medicine Residency Program in Community Medicine. He was AHEC Faculty for the University of Florida College of Medicine for first year medical students and served as a clinical preceptor for second year Physician Assistant students on Family Medicine rotation from University of Florida.

Dr. Mirabile is a Diplomat of both the American Board of Addiction Medicine and the American Board of Family Medicine. He has been recognized as a Fellow by the American Academy of Family Physicians (FAAFP) and has been certified by the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM).
